Birth Certificates (Georgia and out of state)	1 st come/1 st served; limited number each day	1 per lifetime; to obtain ID or for limited other purposes that must be documented
Georgia ID Cards	1 st come/1 st served	2 per lifetime
Emergency Food Pantry (Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays)	Must call the business day before to make an appointment	Every 30 days; Proof of residence and ID for everyone in household
Friends and Neighbors Network (FANN)	2 nd and 4 th Thursdays	See staff to join the waiting list
Eye Clinic (Prescription Glasses)	Appointments made prior to clinic – call for next available date	1 per lifetime
Reading Glasses	1 st come/1 st served	2 per year
Referrals: clothing, dental, medical, vision, mental health, substance abuse, legal, emergency shelter, homeless verification letters	1 st come/1 st served	
Food Stamp Assistance (Monday-Wednesday, Friday)	1 st come/1 st served	Must have some form of picture ID
Main Frame Job Readiness Program	Must attend orientation – call for next available date	Screened by Staff
