

Winter Weather Shelter Update

January 29, 2019

Due to the expected winter weather, the City of Atlanta announced that the emergency warming centers will open at 6am Tuesday, January 29, 2019.

The warming centers are located at the **Old Adamsville Recreation Center**, 3404 Delmar Lane NW, Atlanta, GA 30331 and the **Central Park Recreation Center**, 400 Merritts Avenue North East, Atlanta, GA 30308.

Transportation will be provided from the Gateway Center, 275 Pryor Street, SW, beginning at **6am Tuesday morning**.

Men, women and children are welcome at the two city warming centers.

City overflow should be utilized once existing shelter overflow, which is listed below, has been exhausted.

The shelters listed below will all also activate and offer cold weather overflow when the temps drop below 40 and 35 degrees (see notes for specifics). Also, please note some early openings, due to the expected weather.

At 40 degrees and below:
