Friends and Neighbors Network (FANN)	2 nd and 4 th Thursdays	Screened by Program Director; call 404-601-3173 for more information
Eye Clinic (Prescription Glasses)	Appointments made prior to clinic – call for next available date	1 per lifetime/ Provided Every 3-4 Months
Reading Glasses	1 st come/1 st served	2 per year
Referrals: clothing, dental, medical, vision, mental health, substance abuse, emergency shelter, homeless verification letters	1 st come/1 st served	No limit
Food Stamp Assistance (Monday-Wednesday, Friday)	1 st come/1 st served	Must have picture ID
